

ORDINANCE #20-0001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRINITY TEXAS, ADOPTING THE CITY OF TRINITY'S CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL AND BACKFLOW PREVENTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Trinity recognizes the state requirements posed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to people and property connected to the City of Trinity's water supply; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City Council demonstrates our commitment to the cross-connection control and backflow prevention program and achieving the goals and laws outlined in the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; and

WHEREAS, Russell Crawley shall act as the Authorized Representative in all matters in connection with the City of Trinity's Cross-Connection Control and Backflow Prevention Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF TRINITY:
