

ARTICLE 6.400. ACCUMULATION OF GARBAGE, TRASH AND RUBBISH**Sec. 6.401. Terms defined.**

The terms used in this article shall be defined as follows:

- (1) *Garbage* shall mean kitchen refuse, all meat, vegetable and fruit refuse, small dead animals and fowl, from any premises in the city limits.
- (2) *Trash* shall mean paper of all kinds, rags, old clothing, paper containers, old rubber, pieces of wood, boxes, barrels, crates, feathers, weeds, grass, clippings, and tree limbs.
- (3) *Rubbish* shall mean tin cans, bottles, glass, scraps of iron, tin, wire, or other metals.

Sec. 6.402. Prohibiting accumulations of garbage, trash, and rubbish.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to place, deposit, or throw, or permit to be placed, deposited, or thrown, or cause to be placed, deposited, or thrown, any garbage, trash, or rubbish on any public or private property within the city limits of the City of Trinity, unless such garbage, trash, or rubbish is placed, deposited, or thrown in a place regularly used for that purpose on property owned or occupied by such person, firm, or corporation.
