

Sec. 10.406. Parking prohibited in certain places.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any operator to stop, stand, or park any vehicle upon a street, other than an alley, in such manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten feet of the width of the roadway free for movement of vehicular traffic, except on streets on which no parking is allowed during the actual unloading or loading of passengers or when necessary in obedience to traffic regulations or traffic signs, signals, or a Police officer.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any operator to park a vehicle within an alley in such manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any operator to park any vehicle within 300 feet of any burning building, structure, or thing where fire fighting apparatus is being used for the purpose of extinguishing same, except under the direction of the chief or other officer of the fire department, or a police officer of the city.

Sec. 10.407. Parking prohibited during certain hours in designated places.

The operator or driver of any vehicle shall not park such vehicle between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. of any day within the district or streets designated by the city council, by resolution, except in accordance with the time limit specified on the official signs and signals and other provisions of this article; Sundays and legal holidays excepted. Signs shall be placed or erected and maintained in each block designating the provisions of this article upon the passage of such resolution.

Sec. 10.408. All night parking prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to park said vehicle for a period of time longer than 30 minutes between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any street designated by the city council by resolution.

Sec. 10.409. Parking vehicles for sale prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park upon a street any vehicle displayed for the purpose of selling same.

Sec. 10.410. Using vehicles for primary purpose of displaying advertising prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park in any street any vehicle for the primary purpose of displaying advertising.

Sec. 10.411. Parking along side state highway 19.

(a) No parking will be permitted from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday on the west side of State Highway 19 in the entire block from Jefferson Street (Hwy. Engr. Sta. No. 436 + 34, cont. 109-7) to San Jacinto Street (Hwy. Engr. Sta. No. 439 + 28, cont. 109-7) a distance of 249 feet.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on that portion of State Highway 19 as designated above by "no parking" signs.

(b) "No parking" will be permitted on the west side of State Highway 19 from its intersection with Rockdale Street to its intersection with Elm Street.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on, that portion, of State Highway 19 designated above as "NO PARKING" and the penalties as set out in our ordinance regulating traffic will be applicable to anyone violating this ordinance.

Sec. 10.412. Police authorized to tow cars to pound.

Any official of the City of Trinity, or any police officer, or any agent of the city is hereby given authority to tow or cause to be towed to the city pound or other place designated by the city administrator as a pound, any vehicle which is parked in violation of any of the provisions of this article.
